A Black Miau primitive farm house - note the grave of a village ancestor on which the old woman is sitting.




Black Miau woman returning from work in the gardens, with her infant.



Travelling up the Western rivers of Ghina, through mountain gorgeshauled along by men pulling on long bamboo ropes. Note men among the rocks.




A newly made "Motor Road' in Kweiyang, the capital city of Kweichow, West China-note the ancient Memorial Arches left by the Motor Road.
